ROUND-UP

In August 2006, Uruguay had been Unofficial Football World Champions for four matches. They then defeated Egypt 2-0, but then lost to Venezuela in September, who became UFWC Champions for the very first time. However, Venezuela's reign was short-lived - a return fixture in October saw Uruguay reclaim the title with a 4-0 win. Again, however, the title changed hands quickly, when Georgia beat Uruguay 2-0 in November. Georgia defeated Turkey 1-0 in February 2007, but then lost the title to Scotland in March, via a 2-1 defeat. All-time champions Scotland only held the current title for four days, losing 2-0 to Italy, who became undisputed Official and Unofficial Football World Champions. Italy beat the Faroe Islands 2-1 and Lithuania 2-0 in June, but then lost 3-1 to Hungary in August. In September Hungary defeated Bosnia-Herzegovina 1-0 before losing 3-0 to Turkey. It was Turkey's first ever UFWC title win. Turkey held off Moldova in a 1-1 draw in October, but then lost 1-0 to Greece, who became the joint Official European and Unofficial World Football Champions. In November Greece thrashed Malta 5-0 and then beat Hungary 2-1. 2007 ended with Greece holding the Unofficial Football World Championships title. Greece began 2008 by defeating Finland 2-1 in February.
